OUR INTEGRATION SYSTEM

Integration of Knowledge at DIS translates to and implies that any form of behavior; both actions and spoken words, should be in accordance to the Islamic moral principles and teachings. Hence, for all subjects taught at DIS, the foundation still remains the same and that is, the Islamic perspective of the content learnt. We endeavor to mould students to become God conscious and always to be mindful of their behaviour. Our guiding principles for all their acts in life is to consider the following three most important questions:

Am I pleasing Allah? Am I benefitting from this? What are the consequences?

Those questions are the fundamental guide of our students' behavior. In the hadeeth, it is narrated that: The messenger of Allah did not indulge in gross talk nor did he like to listen to it. He used to say, "The best of you is the best among you in conduct." {Bukhari and Muslim}





THE ISLAMIYAAT CURRICULUM

Here at Deenway International School, we follow our unique curriculum. We are also in constant communication with other Islamic International Institutions to see how best we can update our curriculum.

Currently we have a curriculum that covers the basic knowledge of Islam which is essential to every Muslim.

- 1-DUAS: We start our day with Morning prayers (Adhkar swabah) from the book "Hisnul Muslim". Other duas are also learnt, but in different Islamiyaat lessons.
- 2-QUR'AN: We have daily Qur'an lessons, from Monday to Friday.
- **3-ARABIC:** We also have Arabic lessons. The curriculum is focused on teaching students the basic use of common Arabic expressions, including reading and writing skills.
- **4- HADEETH:** A selection of hadeeth is taught. The hadeeths are based on moral behaviour and thus are focused into building a students' personality.
- 5- TAWHEED: This subject is aimed at equipping a student the basic facts about his beliefs and also to emphasize on the correct beliefs.
- 6- FIQH: This subject focuses on teaching a student the different and basic form of ibadaat. It also aimsat ensuring that a student perform the daily ibada at correctly.
- 7- ISLAMIC STUDIES: This subject is adopted from the Pearson-Edexcel. However, special attention is given to the Seerah part (History of the prophet). For that reason, we didn't include a separate Seerah subject to avoid repetition. We have, therefore, mandated that all student must take Islamic Studies as one of the examinable subjects.
